The 5 Elements of Effective Thinking

1. Heart: Thinking about my life and leadership.

Keep a close watch on yourself and on the teaching. 1 Timothy 4:16 Gen. Dempsey: The question we don't ask is, "How do I feel about my leadership?"

- (1) Mission: What am I here to do? This addresses my life calling.
- (2) Values: Why am I doing it? This addresses my life convictions (values).
- (3)Strategy: How am I doing it? This addresses my roles and rhythms of life.
- (4) Measures: When am I successful? This addresses my story lines. (5) Vision proper: Where is God taking me? This addresses my horizons.
- 2. Vision: Thinking about where we are going.

I told ... what God had put in my heart to do for Jerusalem. Nehemiah 2:12 (1) What are we here to do? (3) Where are we going?

- (2) Why are we doing it? (4) What's most important right now?
- **3. System:** Thinking about our people, structures, processes.

If you do this and God so commands, you will be able to stand the strain, and all these people will go home satisfied. Exodus 18:23
